KEMY HOOIJMEIER is a Dutch musical theater performer. She graduated form the Frank Sanders Akademie and is currently pursuing a Master of Music at Fontys Academy of the Arts. Kemy has performed in Rapunzel de Musical (Theater Terra) as Mother Gothel and Pride & Prejudice de Musical (Morssinkhof Terra) as Mother Bennet and Mr. Darcy.

ESMEE TEMPELS graduated in 2022 from Fontys School of Fine and Performing Arts, specializing in Musical Theatre. She performed in Musicalspektakel 1830 in Belgium, taking on a featured role and understudying a lead. She then joined 'Soldaat van Oranje - De Musical', the Netherlands' longest-running production, and later appeared in 'De Nieuwe Lichting Doet Auditie', a showcase for emerging talent.

Alongside her stage work, Esmee writes, directs, and performs in a comedy series for BNNVARA, created for social media.

WESLEY DE RIDDER graduated from the Frank Sanders Academy and has been a key artist at Theater Terra, performing lead roles in productions like Guess How Much I Love You and Snowwhite. He later trained in puppetry at Gyre & Gimble in London and has since directed over 15 productions touring the Netherlands and Belgium. Wesley was the artistic director of Disney's Winnie the Pooh and played Tigger in the Dutch production. His work has also taken him to Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan.

In addition to theater, he is a voice actor for Disney's Wish, Care Bears, The Unstoppable Yellow Yeti, and Inside Out: Dream Productions.

LAURENS VINK is a graduate of the Frank Sanders Academy in Amsterdam, specializing in musical theatre. At the age of 21, Laurens performed as Christopher Robin and Little Roo in the Dutch and Belgian tour of Disney's Winnie the Pooh: The Musical. Additionally, Laurens participated as an actor in the workshop development of a new Dutch musical currently in progress. Currently, Laurens performs in various musical productions at a children's theatre in Amsterdam and works as a singing waiter in the same city. Beyond performing, Laurens has a strong passion for writing original repertoire.
